This is a provisional position pending a future civil service exam in the Dutchess County Department of Public Works – Highway Division. This is an important working supervisor position for the Department of Public Works. The incumbent has overall responsibility for the County's fleet of vehicles, trucks, and highway construction and maintenance equipment used by the Department of Public Works Highway Construction and Maintenance Division, including machinery and heavy-duty trucks used at other Divisions within the Public Works Department and other departments. This responsibility includes overseeing maintenance, repairs, equipment modification, parts management, and overall garage facility management. This position differs from the Automotive Service Center Supervisor title in that the Automotive Center Supervisor position is focused primarily on the automotive and light-duty truck fleet used by other County agencies. The work is performed under the general supervision of a higher-level management employee. General supervision is exercised over technical and other subordinate personnel.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- EITHER: (A) Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma and Five (5) years of full-time paid supervisory or administrative work experience in the field of automotive repair that includes at least three years of experience involving diesel trucks or heavy equipment;
- OR: (B) Two (2) years permanent competitive class status in Transit Equipment Mechanic Supervisor or Automotive Service Center Supervisor;
- OR: (C) Three (3) years of permanent competitive class status as a Stockroom Supervisor;
- OR: (D) Four (4) years of permanent non-competitive class status as Construction Equipment Mechanic II or Senior Automotive Mechanic.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

1. Candidates must possess a valid New York State Class B Commercial Driver License at time of appointment. This license must have CDL endorsements for tanker vehicles and hazardous materials, and contain no restrictions other than those relating to personal physical conditions. Such restrictions will be reviewed on a case by case basis for compatibility with job duties and will not be an automatic bar to employment.
2. Possession of a valid New York State Motor Vehicle Inspector certificate for both light and heavy duty vehicles.

SPECIAL NOTE: Applicants for positions that require driving a commercial motor vehicle (CMV) at any time will be required to undergo controlled substances and at our discretion, alcohol testing prior to employment and will be subject to further testing throughout their period of employment. Applicants will also be asked to sign forms for release of information from previous employers in all cases where driving a CMV was one of your functions. Failure to sign will prevent this employer from using you as a CMV driver.

FINGERPRINTING: A fingerprint supported background investigation is required before an appointment is made to some positions. Pursuant to New York State Executive Law, the Division of Criminal Justice Services requires that a fee accompany each such request for a search. It is due once a job offer is made and accepted by the applicant.
