



NURSE PRACTITIONER (Hourly)

This is a clinical position in the Department of Health responsible for the provision of medical care working in collaboration with a licensed physician in accordance with a written practice agreement and medical protocols. Services provided include evaluation, diagnosis, prescription of medication and treatment of patients with the goal of achieving stabilization and optimal health. As a Nurse Practitioner in the Department of Health, you will also provide direct medical care in a variety of specialty clinics, which may involve work outside of normal business hours. Work is performed under the direction of a higher level licensed employee. Supervision of others may be a responsibility of the position.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

Provides medical care and treatment to patients in a variety of clinic settings such as: Sexually Transmitted Disease (STD) Clinic, Tuberculosis Clinic, and Immunization Clinic; oversight of clinic operations and directs staff during clinics; ensures compliance with New York State Department of Health Diagnostic and Treatment Center regulations; responsible for Dutchess County Exposure Control Program; orders and interprets lab tests; prescribes treatment; makes appropriate referrals as necessary; maintains, reviews, and monitors patient records and related data; participates in Quality Assurance activities; responds to subpoenas.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Possession of a current New York State Nurse Practitioner license with a specialization in Family Practice.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT:

Current CPR and AED certification at time of application.

Possession of a valid Driver License to operate a motor vehicle in New York State at time of application, and to maintain the position.

FINGERPRINTING: A fingerprint supported background investigation is required before an appointment is made to some positions. Pursuant to New York State Executive Law, the Division of Criminal Justice Services requires that a fee accompany each such request for a search. It is due once a job offer is made and accepted by the applicant.
